Try street food in Chandni Chowk. Don't miss parathas at Paranthe Wali Gali and kebabs at Karim's and chole bhature.


Explore the historic architecture in Chandni Chowk, a treasure trove of secrets is a gem. This corner is of nine gorgeously painted Jain havelis.

10 MINS WALK TO LAJPAT NAGAR MARKET




